ASLA rejoining IFLA

- ASLA has been a member of the International Federation of Landscape Architects (IFLA) for most of the
 past three decades but our engagement over the last few years has ebbed and flowed for a variety
 reasons such as changes in leadership, governance structure and financial constraints.
- Under new direction over the last few years, IFLA has instituted sounder governance practices and financial accountability.
- Membership in IFLA is a more strategic and cost-effective way to broaden ASLA's outreach to international audiences, engage on the global stage on issues like climate change and sustainability and, in turn, provide our members with resources and networks that will enhance their careers and development.
- The Executive Committee voted to reinstate our standing in IFLA during its December meeting. The 2021 budget includes funding for international programming and the expected dues (roughly \$20,000 based on our full membership count) for IFLA would be covered by those earmarked funds.
