In 2016, the ASLA Board of Trustees established two new committees, the Student Advisory Committee and Associate Advisory Committee. The purpose of these committees is to increase the ability of ASLA to gain insight on the priorities of emerging professionals and learn how best to provide membership value to student and associate members. Committee selections are made from candidates who have been <u>nominated by the professional chapters</u>. It's just not sustainable and I'm at a loss of what to do as I've followed up with firms the past 3 years to no avail. I will do so again this year (Browning Day, Context, Ratio, HWC). Maybe our approach needs to change, but that's another conversation for another day.
- We could use a couple volunteers for the day of to help with morning registration and then awards social set up. I know you've helped in the past, but one other would probably be helpful.
